



PHOTO TREASURE BOOK

Suits ages 18 - 60 months



What you will need:

- Recent and older photos of family members, friends and pets
- Pencils and coloured paper
- Glue

What you do:

1. Take a selection of printed photographs of family, friends and pets and gather them all together.
2. Let your child select photos of interest to them; ask them who is in the pictures, talk about now and then, differences and similarities, past and present (depending on the picture selected).
3. Let your child decide which photos they would like to have in their treasure book.
4. Let your child glue the picture into their treasure book and ask them who is in the picture and ask if they can remember what they were doing (depends on the picture).
5. Write next to the picture what your child has said.
6. After each picture leave a blank page, this space is for your child to draw the people or pets from the photo.

This is a great activity to let your child explore photos of people and/or pets who are familiar to them. Allowing your child to decorate the book with their own drawings creates a unique keepsake which they can revisit at any time.

You will be supporting your child's language skills whilst you talk about the photos and their drawings will help support their creative development.
