



ALPHABET MEMORY

Suits ages 40 months – 60 months



What you'll need:

- 24 paper plates/cards
- Pen

What you do:

1. Take 12 of the plates or cards and write 12 different letters on them, and then write the same letters on the other 12.
2. Place the plates or cards upside down in a 4x6 grid on a table.
3. Ask your child to choose two plates at random to see if they can find 2 that match.
4. If they don't match they are replaced face down, if they do match they are kept by the child.

The game is all about remembering the letters you've seen before and matching them up with new ones you discover. This is great for growing memories and practising turn taking whilst helping your child to recognise letters.

This activity can be extended to using numbers and pictures.
