





The opportunity to discuss numbers and help your child learn about letters and their associated sounds is available throughout. If your child does not already know the letter, sound or number, you can help to scaffold their learning by sharing the correct answer. Repetition is essential in order for children to learn.

This activity gives the opportunity to develop language skills through conversation and questioning, concentration and perseverance also.

Self-care: If you have used gloop or jelly, once the activity has finished, why not encourage your child to wash and dry all of the resources ready for use another day? Taking care of their resources is both necessary and important, and encourages ownership of the whole process.
